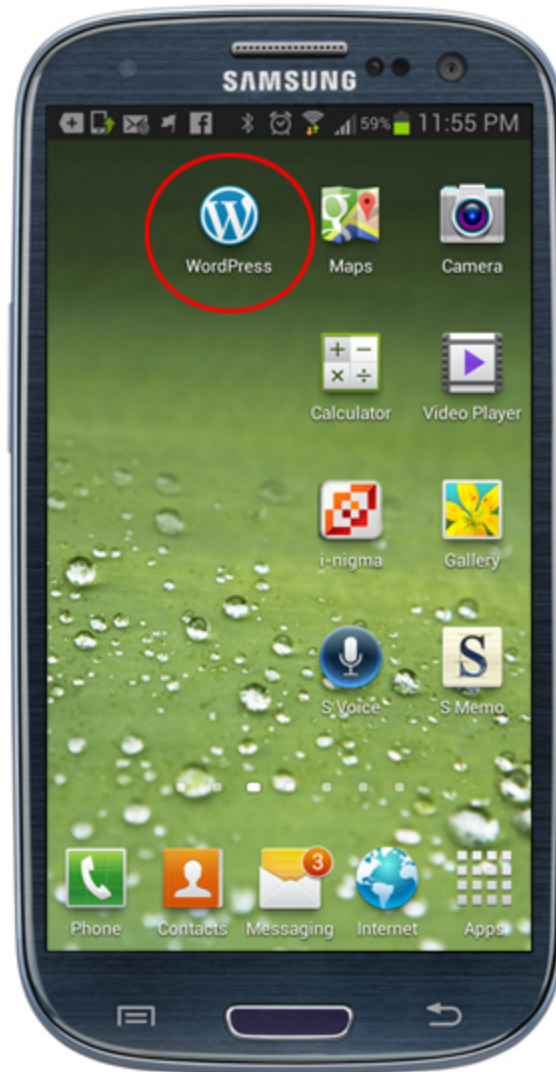
- For this tutorial, we'll use the **WordPress For Android** version of the WordPress mobile app. The process explained below is similar for iOS devices (e.g. iPhone, iPod Touch, or iPad). For more information about WordPress For IOS, go here: **WordPress For iOS**
- While the screenshots in this tutorial use an earlier version of the WordPress App and android mobile device, the process described below for installing and using the app is the same.
- This tutorial will also help you better understand the topic covered below: **How To Manage Comments In WordPress**

## **The WordPress Mobile App – Comments**

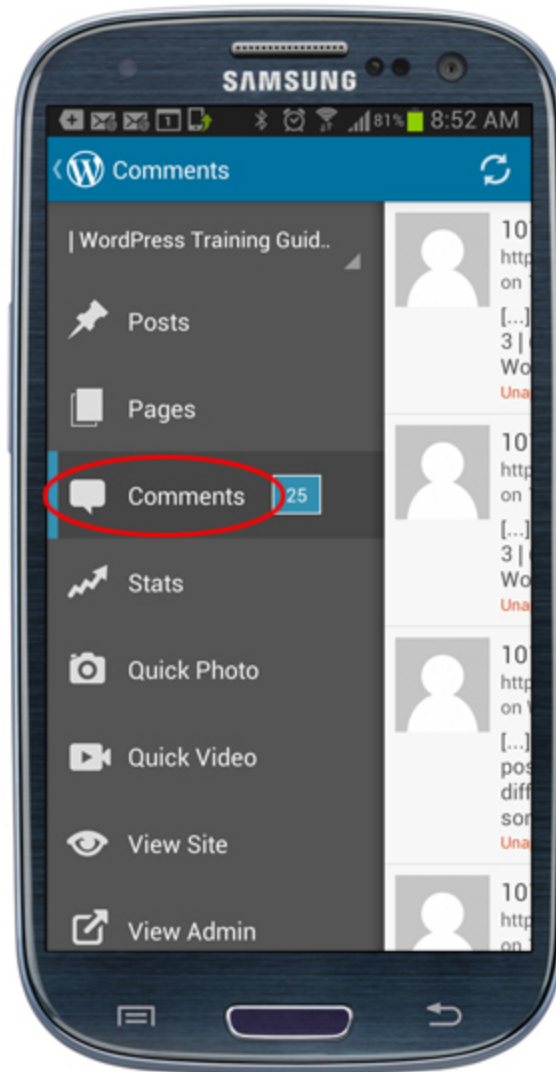

Tap on your WordPress app icon to log into your account.



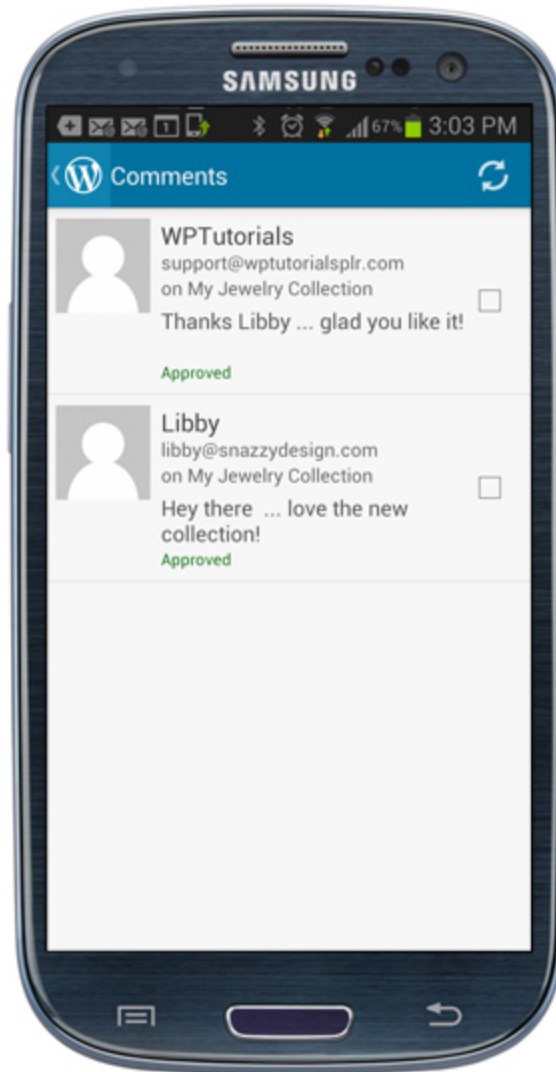
Select the WordPress App to launch the application on your mobile device.

To moderate and manage your comments, tap on the **Comments** menu.



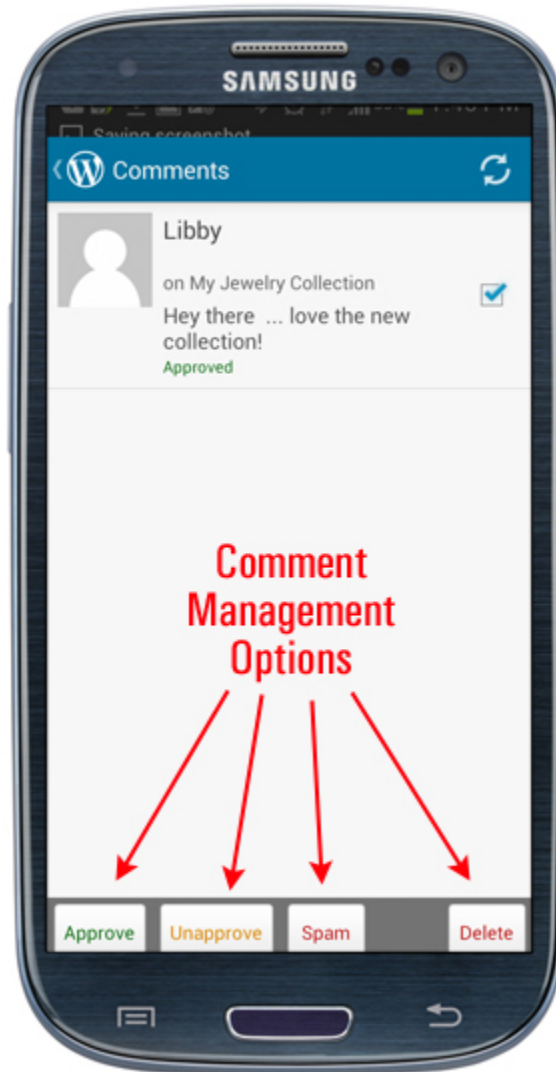
Select Comments from the menu.

The *Comments* screen displays on your browser.



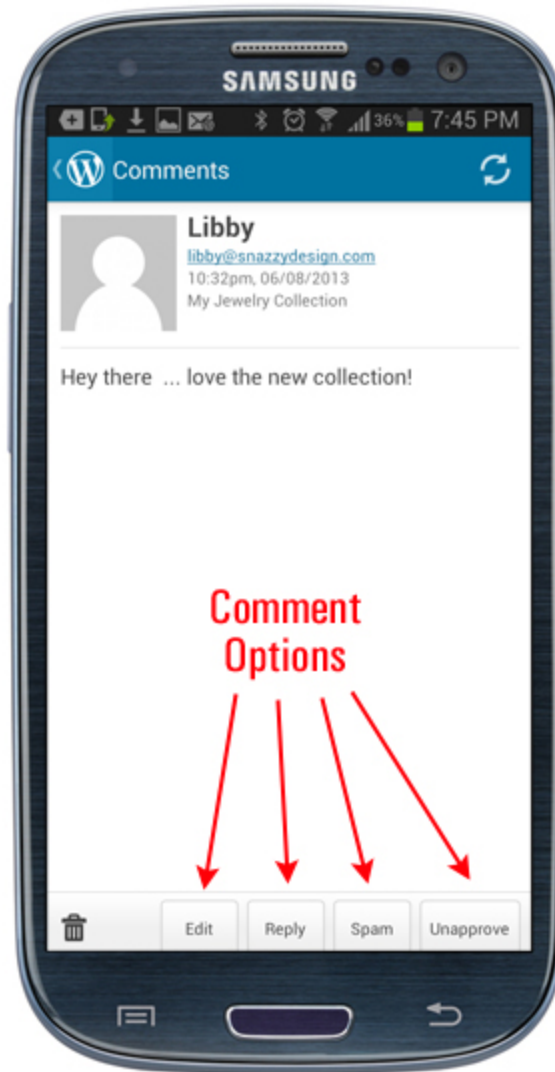
WordPress App – Comments Screen.

To view the comment management options, either tick the checkbox to select the comment.



WordPress App – Comment Management Options.

Or tap on the comment itself.



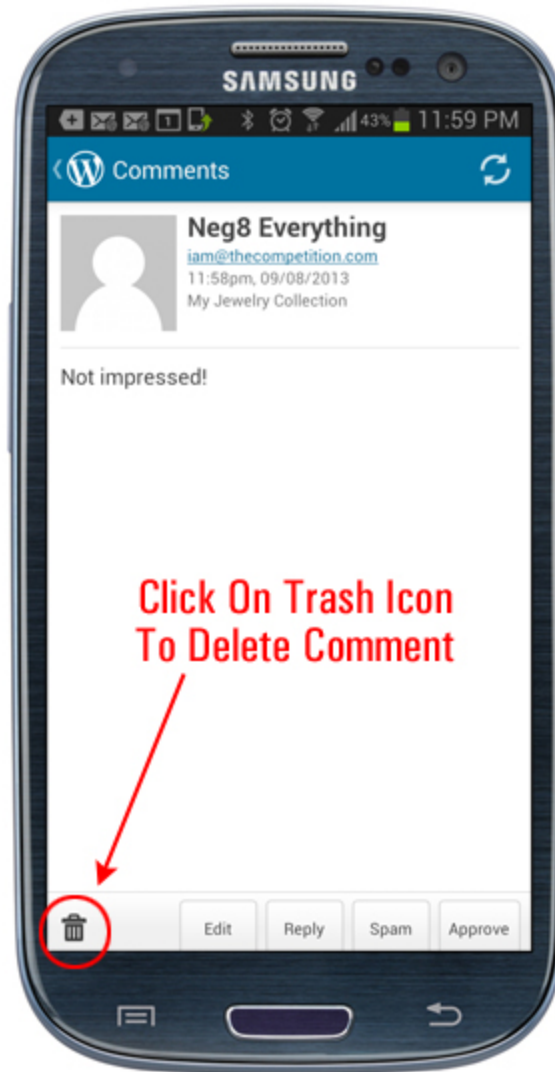
WordPress App – Comment Options.

The Comment management screen lets you perform the following functions:

- Delete The Comment
- Edit The Comment
- Reply To The Comment
- Mark the Comment as Spam
- Approve/Unapprove The Comment

### **Delete Comment**

To delete a comment click on the *Trash Can* icon.



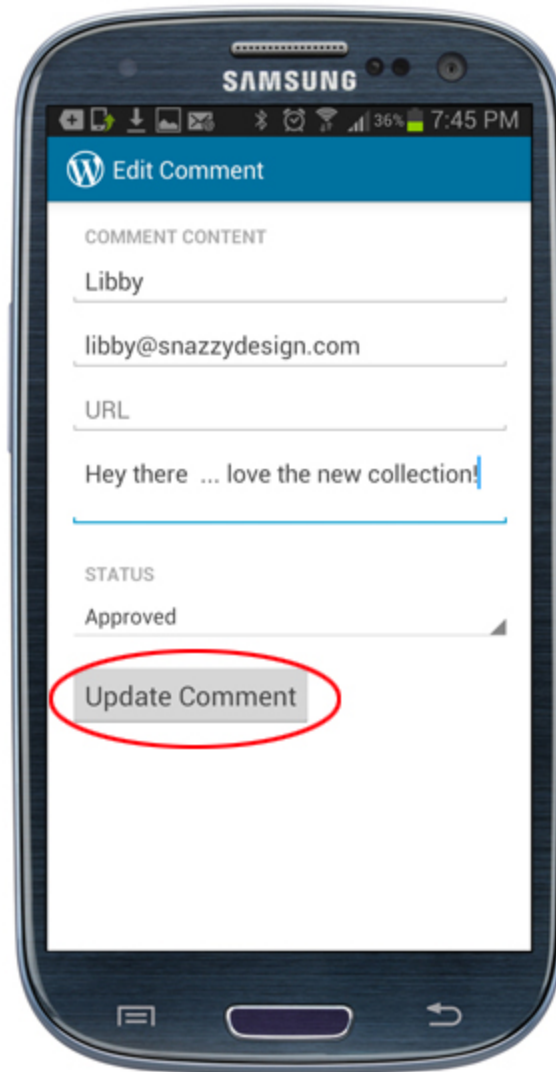
Click on the trash icon to delete your comment.

The comment will be immediately deleted.

### **Edit Comment**

Selecting the *Edit Comment* option brings up the Edit Comments screen. Here you can edit the comment fields, moderate the comment and change the comment status to *Approved*, *Pending Review*, or *Spam*. Tap on the *Update Comment* button when done.

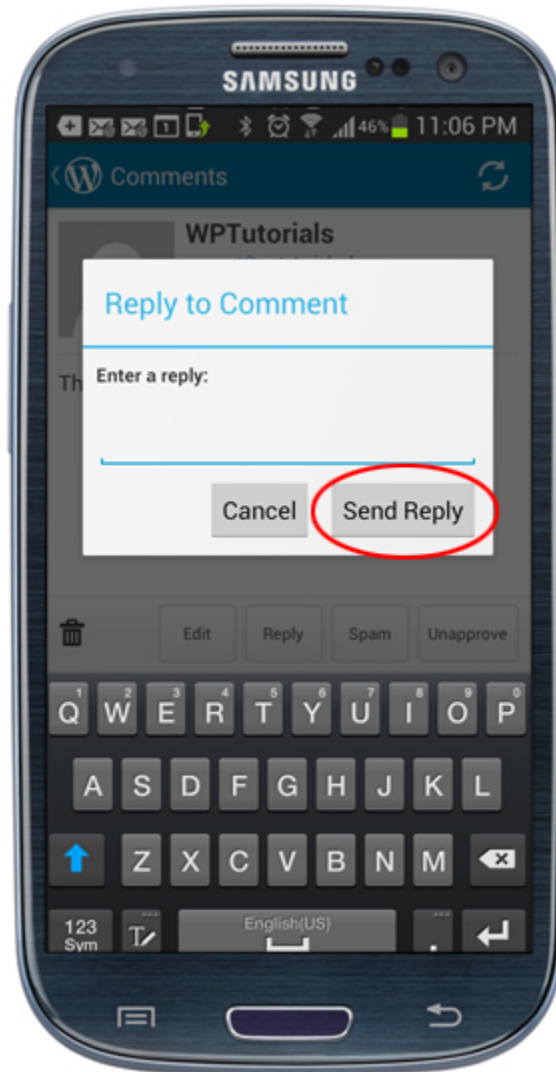




WordPress App – Update Comment button.

## Reply To Comment

To post a reply to an existing comment, select the *Reply* button. This brings up the *Reply to Comment* screen. Type your reply, then tap *Send Reply* to post your reply on your WordPress site.



Post a comment reply from your mobile device.

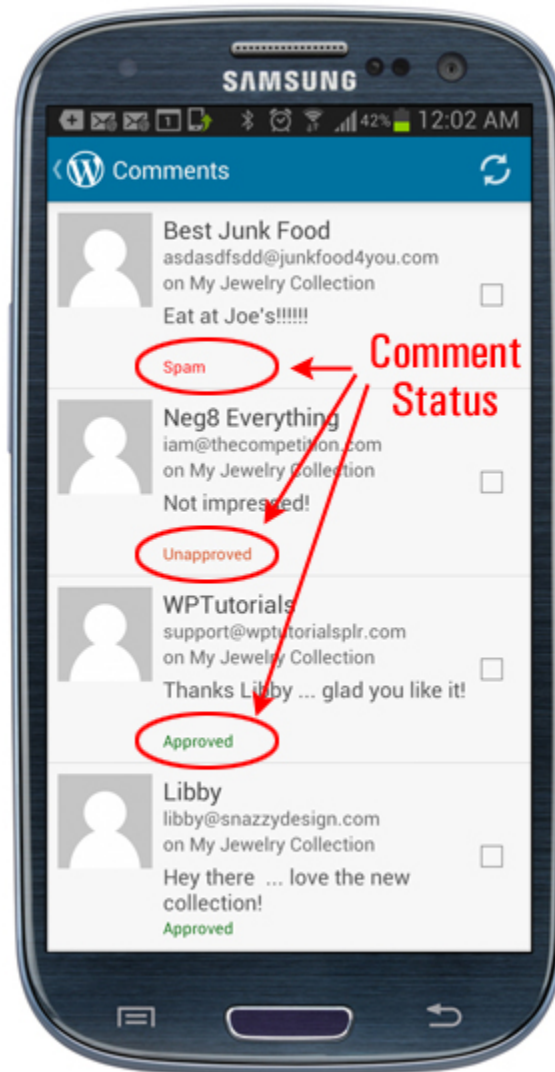
### **Mark Comment As Spam**

Select *Spam* to flag comments as spam. Comments marked as spam display in your Comments screen (see below).

### **Approve/Unapprove Comment**

To approve or unapprove comments, select the comment, and tap the Approve/Unapprove toggle button to change the comment status.

Approved and Unapproved comments display in your Comments section.
