

Action Step

- Create a new post, add content (text and media), preview, and publish.
- Create a new page, add content, preview, and publish.
- Create and schedule a new post to publish at a later date.
- Create a new post or page and save it as a draft.
- Create a password-protected post or page. Log out of your site and visit your post or page to test and access your protected content. Permanently delete the post or page if it is no longer required.
- Implement your post publishing schedule (from lesson 2) to begin adding content regularly to your website.
